

Somerset West Soccer Club 2017 Fall Recreational Microsoccer (Kindergarten and First Grade)



Come join us this fall in the Somerset West Soccer Club (SWSC) microsoccer program for kindergarteners and first graders living in the Rock Creek, Lenox, Elmonica, Bethany, Springville, and McKinley Elementary School attendance areas. Private and home school children living in these areas are also eligible to play with the club.


Players must be at least five years old by August 31, 2017, or be entering kindergarten in September 2017 to be eligible to play in the Fall 2017 season. New this year, teams are single gender (boys and girls will now play on separate microsoccer teams instead of on the same team as in the past) and have players from both kindergarten and first grade. The emphasis is placed on fun, skills development, and team play.

Microsoccer activities take place on Tuesday and Thursday evenings starting September 7 and ending in mid-October. Each session consists of a 30-minute team practice (5:30-6:00 p.m.) and a 30-minute game (6:00-6:30 p.m.) against another microsoccer team. The game format is two simultaneous games of 3 vs. 3 on small fields.

Registration begins on May 1. Early registration is encouraged to ensure placement on desired teams and with desired teammates. After June 15, registration is on a space-available basis.

The 2017 microsoccer season will begin with a jamboree for all players on Thursday, August 24, at Powerlines Park from 6:30-8:00 pm. Coaches will receive their equipment and rosters about one week before the jamboree and will contact their players at that time. You will also be able to access your team information at the online registration site starting Sunday, August 20.

Coaches needed! No experience needed and training is provided. Coaching your child is an experience not to be missed!
